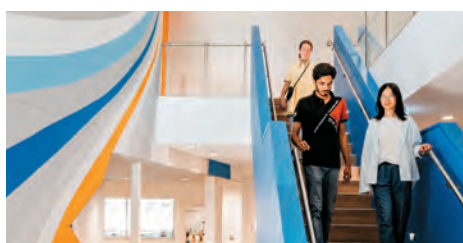
### Campus facilities
