Paid Placement Guarantee*

At Federation, paid work placements are integrated into your study through our Co-operative education model (Co-op). With our Paid Placement Guarantee*, students receive a minimum payment for the placement hours required in their course – up to \$10,000 for undergraduates and \$5,000 for postgraduates. These payments will be distributed in instalments throughout your study.
